Dear Ms. Nielsen:

Ohio EPA has reviewed the May 2, 2023, letter, submitted by WSP on behalf of Cyprus Amax Minerals Company (CAMC), requesting approval to decommission certain ground water monitoring wells at the Former Satralloy Site. As described in the request and summarized in its attached table, some of the wells are located in areas of slag that will be removed as part of the interim action, while other wells are within the footprint of the proposed consolidation area. In either case, the wells require decommissioning in order to prevent damage during construction activities.

CAMC has indicated that as part of the interim action process, a long-term ground water monitoring plan for the site will be developed and submitted for agency review, and could include replacement wells as necessary.
